### Program: Internationally Educated (IEN) RN Post-Licensure Project

- ✓ Are you an internationally educated RN with English as second language?
- ✓ Have you passed the Canadian Registered Nurse Exam (CRNE)?
- ✓ Do you hold a full registration or do you have a temporary registration with the College of Registered Nurses of BC (CRNBC) but still need the 250 hours of supervised practice?
- ✓ Are you looking for permanent full time employment in nursing?
- ✓ Are you eligible to work as a nurse in Canada? Have you practiced as an RN since you graduated?

If you answered **yes** then this pilot project may be for **you!**

If you qualify, you may be hired into a permanent full time position on a medical or surgical acute care unit within **Vancouver Coastal Health** or **Providence Health Care** with:

- Supported extended orientation
- “Nursing in BC” courses through Kwantlen University College
- Preceptor and educator support for your first weeks on the unit
- English language tutoring for your first 4 months of employment
